

Eligibility requirements:

- Fulltime student in the FNP program
- Beyond 4th semester of the program
- Good academic standing, GPA at least 3.0
- Good disciplinary standing
- Committed to completing at least 125 clinical practicum hours at a community-based, primary care clinic located in a medically underserved community.

Required documents:

- Completed application.
- Essay. Essay must be typed and limited to one page, double-spaced, with 1” margins. DO NOT exceed the page limit. Essay must contain discrete sections: (1) explain a little about your background and why you want to be a FNP, (2) indicate your long term goals in nursing and any plans for working with underserved populations, and (3) how the funds will help you achieve these goals.
- CAPP report (Sharklink)

All documents printed on one side of page. Do not staple documents together.
