- Completed application.
- Essay. Essay must be typed and limited to one page double, spaced with 1” margins. Essay must contain three discrete sections: (1) express appreciation for the opportunity to apply for the funds, (2) explain a little about your background and why you want to be a nurse practitioner, nurse educator, nurse administrator or nurse informaticist, (3) indicate your long term goals in nursing and how the funds will help you achieve these goals.
- FASFA report which contains the Student Aid Report (SAR) or current institution financial aid award letter
- CAPP report (Sharklink)

All documents printed on one side of page. Do not staple documents together.
